Walk for Life: Questions and Answers

1. How far do we walk?

Just two miles at any of our 6 Walk sites (see Walk Form for locations).

2. What if someone can't be there that day?

They can simply walk on their own and turn in their walk form later.

3. What if I am unable able to walk 2 miles?

We understand that not everyone will be able to walk the distance. However, you can still raise your support (it is not absolutely necessary that you walk if you are unable).

4. What about collecting money?

Collecting money is not necessary!!! However, if a sponsor gives you money, you can turn it in the day of the Walk. All others will be billed.

5. What if it rains on Walk day?

Bring an umbrella and walk or you may walk on your own on another day.

6. How do I recruit other walkers?

The more people in your church who get walk forms – either through bulletin announcements, pulpit announcements, Sunday School announcements or one-on-one contact – the better chance you have of recruiting walkers. See our hints and tips page for more information.

7. Who should we ask to sponsor us?

You can ask anyone, anywhere, to make a pledge. The possibilities are endless. You can also use the Sponsor Form for Out-of-Town Friends and Relatives.
